Below you will find the aggregated results of our recent survey showing the general trend amongst those who responded.

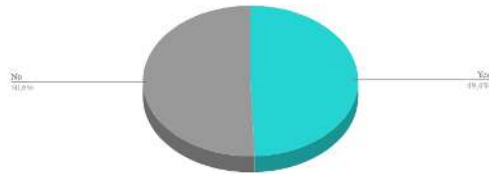
Some notes about the data:

Not all respondents answered all the questions, so some questions will show a total amount of answers that is less than the total amount of survey responses.

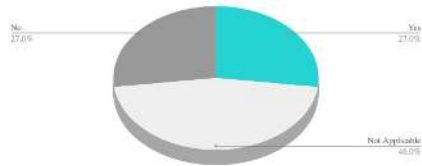


Total responses

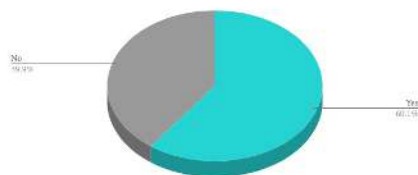
